GUIDED TOURS

CATHEDRAL TOURS

Trained volunteer guides offer tours around the floor of the Cathedral and Chapter House (with Magna Carta) free of charge. Please book in advance for groups, customised tours, non-English languages and any other special requirements. We can also design tours to meet your specific needs.

Guides are on duty:

Monday - Saturday 9.30am to 4.45pm April – October
10.00am to 4.00pm November – March

Sundays 4.00pm to 6.15pm April – October
1.00pm to 3.00pm November – March

Evenings (Mon-Sat) 5.00pm to 7.15pm 8 June – 31 August 2009

Over the Easter period and during December, Christmas and New Year, special services and events may mean that guiding and access are restricted and that the Cathedral closes earlier than normal. Tours by request when possible.

TOWER TOURS

These scheduled tours can be booked in advance by individuals. Explore the spectacular roof space, climbing 332 steps in relatively easy stages. Duration 1½ - 2 hours. Maximum of 12 in each group. Children must be at least five years old and 1.2m tall. Each child between 5 and 10 years old must be individually accompanied by one adult. Children 11 to 17 must be accompanied by one adult for every 5 children. Special tours for pre-booked groups can be arranged outside these times.

£24:00 family (2 adults + 3 children)

Groups (minimum of 15): per person £7.00 adults £5.50 concessions
