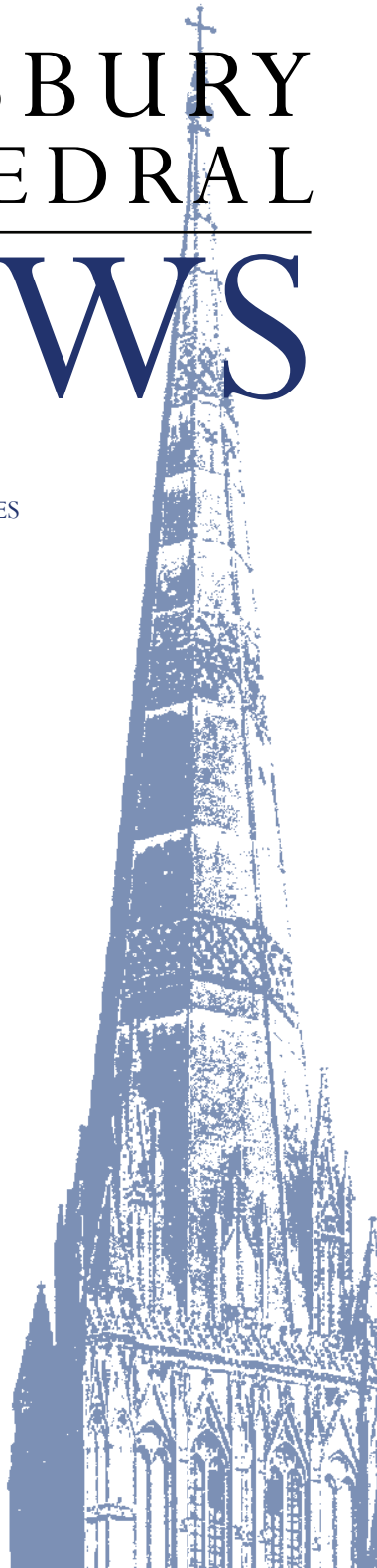

AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL

Comedian, actor and director Zarganar, a critic of the military government of Burma (Myanmar), was sentenced in November to 59 years' imprisonment.

After Cyclone Nargis hit Myanmar in May 2008, Zarganar led efforts to raise and distribute aid from private donors. He was arrested on 4 June 2008 after criticising the government's handling of the crisis in interviews with overseas media. He and other volunteers also documented the cyclone's aftermath and voluntary relief operations. At least 21 other aid volunteers were arrested for helping survivors.
