

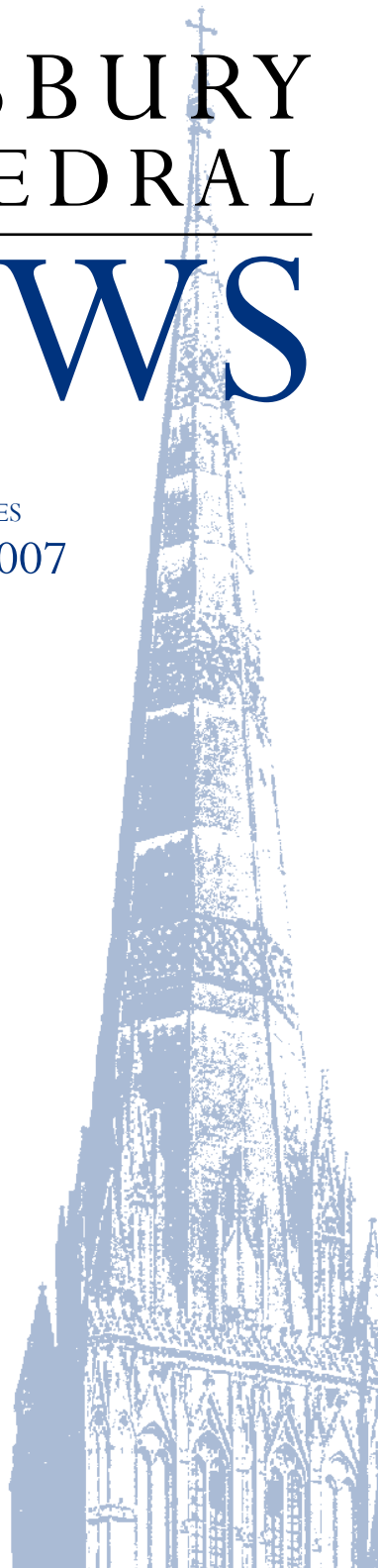

### **Slavery: Alive and Kicking Conference**

This is the theme of a conference on Saturday November 3. Despite the abolition of the Slave Trade in 1807, it still exists today often taking different forms, and much of it hidden. Speakers include John Bell (Iona Community), Dr Carrie Pemberton (Chief Executive of CHASTE), Dr Timothy Brain (Chief Constable of Gloucester) and Michaela Alfred-Kamara (Anti-Slavery International).

The conference is at Sarum College (09.30am - 4:50pm) and costs £25.00 including lunch. After the conference, delegates are invited to Salisbury Methodist Church for a service led by John Bell at 5:30pm.
