Cathedrals Measure - our Constitution and Statutes

The Cathedrals Measure 2021 requires all English Cathedrals to reorder the structures which enable them to function from day to day and, consequently, requires them to rewrite their governing documents. The Cathedral has therefore prepared a new Constitution and new Statutes. These have recently been approved by both the Church Commissioners and the Charity Commission, and accord with what the new Measure requires. We are now sharing these for public comment.
