

What is the best way to give?

The best way to make regular donations to the Cathedral is through the Parish Giving Scheme. This is a national direct debit platform established in 2008 where every penny donated goes to the donor's intended church.

Gifts can be made on a monthly, quarterly or annual basis. You can find our giving page by typing 'PGS Salisbury Cathedral' into your search engine. Alternatively, paper application packs are available from the Chapter Office, 6 The Close, Salisbury SP1 2EF (please either pop in or ring 01722 555105).

The Cathedral continues to receive donations through its earlier standing order scheme, but we encourage those who donate by standing order to change to the Parish Giving Scheme. The Parish Giving Scheme has the advantages of being easier to operate, pays Gift Aid monthly rather than annually which assists our cashflow, and you can also choose to increase your gift annually in line with inflation.
