

Grip (Net) by Antony Gormley

Anthony Gormley is probably the best-known sculptor in Britain today. He has always been interested in the human figure and often uses his own body as a model for his sculptures. The Angel of the North is Gormley's most famous artwork and is ten times taller than the average human.

This figure is made from stainless steel and sits high up in one of the Cathedral arches.



Activity ideas:

- Find out about Anthony Gormley's 'Angel of the North'
- Make your own sculpture using pipe cleaners or aluminium foil
- Follow these instructions to create a flip book animation:
 1. Get a stack of small pieces of paper – between 10 and 20 sheets. A small notebook or sticky notes are ideal.
 2. In the bottom right hand corner of the first page draw a stickman.
 3. Continue by drawing a stickman on the same corner of each page but each time change the image slightly.
 4. Flip through your flipbook and watch the animation.
