15 February **Animal Antics** 10.00-12.00 or 13.00-15.00

Create your very own light sculpture using acetate and film. Seek out some of the animals hiding in the Cathedral on our mini trail and then use your favourites to decorate your creation. Meet in North Transept.

Easter Trail

7 to 16 April **If Easter Could Speak**

Visit a series of reflective stations around the Cathedral. Families can collect a free map at the Cathedral entrance any time, except during services, and follow the special route through the building to find displays and materials to help you explore together what Easter is about. Suitable for age 4 years upwards.

19 April **Talking Textures** 10.00 -12.00 or 13.00 -15.00

Get busy with rubbing crayons and collect textures from the Cathedral floor and using the Eleanor Bartlett exhibition be inspired to create your very own personalised mixed media collage. Meet in the North Transept.

31 May **Remember Me** 10.00 -12.00 or 13.00 -15.00

Seek out the artwork in the Ana Maria Pacheco exhibition and then using a range of paints and with the help of a mirror create a portrait of yourself. Meet in the Trinity Chapel.

There are so many fascinating faces both outside and inside Salisbury Cathedral. How many can you find as you walk around? Collect your trail inside the Cathedral and get detecting straight away! Available each day except during services.
