

<b>KS2 Lesson Plan</b>	
<b>The Road to Power</b>	
<b>Objectives</b>	To consider different types of power and its use To explore what is an effective use of power To understand how power affects individuals and others around them
<b>National curriculum</b>	PSHE
<b>Resources</b>	Large sheets of paper Board markers Materials for construction
<b>Teaching activities</b>	Discuss different meanings of power.  In groups, children to nominate one person to lie down on a large sheet of paper and be drawn round.  The group members annotate the diagram as to where power comes from (all types) Eg from hands - power to hurt/power to do good things or from tongue - harsh words/motivating words  Discuss and compare the drawings.  One definition of power is influence. Who has power (influence)? What was King John's power? How did he use it? In groups, design the best 'body' for power (influence) in a positive way and make a working model, explaining each part.
<b>Plenary</b>	Who does not have influence? How does it make them feel?
<b>Extension</b>	Research one person who used/uses power well and one person who didn't/doesn't. What was different in the way they used power? What effects did they have?

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
