

<b>KS2 Lesson Plan</b> <b>Towards Justice</b>	
<b>Objectives</b>	To understand what Magna Carta achieved in furthering justice and rights To explore how rights and justice affects individuals and societies
<b>National curriculum</b>	PSHE
<b>Resources</b>	Link to Salisbury Cathedral website Microphone, news desk etc
<b>Teaching activities</b>	Use the link to the Key Clauses of Magna Carta on the website resource.  Discuss each of the clauses as a class - who does this affect? How important is it? Why?  Prepare in groups a news broadcast outlining the anniversary of Magna Carta (at any chosen point in history) and its achievements - it could contain an interview with a criminal/judge/victim of crime/grocer/woman who has received the vote for the first time/soldier fighting for American independence/Medieval King or Queen/modern day lawyer. Act these out/record/film.
<b>Plenary</b>	Decide which of the clauses have become more important or which less important over the centuries?
<b>Extension</b>	Do a survey of ten adults and children to see what 3 things they think would make the world a fairer place for everyone. Prepare a chart and a brief report of your findings.

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
